1 VENUE

- 1.1 The event will be held at Univela Sailing, in Campione del Garda (bs), Italy
- 1.2 The racing area will be in front of Univela Sailing
- 1.3 Further venue information are available at info@campioneunivela.it

2 RULES

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing except as any of these is altered by this notice of race or by the Sailing Instructions and/or the WASZP class rules.
- 2.2 The Italian National prescriptions will not apply.
- 2.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

3 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on 1st August 2017 at Univela Sailing.

4 FEE & PAYMENT

- 4.1 Entry fee: € 160,00 to be pay by the 10th of July 2017
- 4.2 Late entries will be accepted under the following condition: extra fee € 50,00
- 4.3 The entry fee must be paid in Euro (no other currencies will be accepted)
- 4.4 Follow the instructions on the entry form for payment online.

5 CANCELLATION & REFUND

- 5.1 50% of the entry fee paid is refundable for cancellations received until the 10th of July 2017. No entry fee is refundable after the 10th of July 2017. The request has to be send per email at info@campioneunivela.it , has to include IBAN and BIC code of the same person who paid the entry fee. The refund will be paid net of bank charges.

6 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 6.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the WASZP class.
- 6.2 All sailors shall be a member of their National WASZP Class Association or the International WASZP Class Association. All WASZP sailors registered for the event will receive complimentary short term membership of the International WASZP Class Association.
- 6.3 Entry form must be send online through the website <http://www.campioneunivela.it/it/eventi-regata.php>
The entry form must be completely filled, confirmed at the bottom
- 6.4 Follow the instructions on the entry form for payment online.
The boat will be shown into the entry list only after a correct registration and payment.
- 6.5 All helms less than 18 years of age during the event shall submit signed Parent/Guardian Declarations either by post or at registration.

7 FORMAT OF RACING

The regatta will be run as a single fleet series, or, with a large number of entries, the fleet will be divided into groups and racing will consist of a qualifying series and a final series.

8 SCHEDULE

- 8.1 Registration will take place on

31 st July	from	09:00 to 17:00
1 st August	from	09:00 to 17:00, Opening Ceremony with welcome drinks



8.2 The schedule of races, including qualifying and final series races if applicable, is as follows:

8.3 The sailing instructions will specify a time on the last day after which no warning signal may be made.

9 RACING FORMATS

10.1 The event will consist of one or more of the following racing formats:

- Course Racing - the courses will be windward/leeward or trapezoid
- Slalom – the course will be a short format including multiple gybe marks
- Marathon – the course may include upwind and downwind legs run over a long distance

10.2 Additionally, a GPS based speed event for best times achieved during racing

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.1 is changed so that The Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11 SCORING

11.1 A minimum of three races shall be completed to constitute a regatta.

11.2 When a split fleet qualifying and final series format is used:

11.2.1 The qualifying series will consist of a maximum of 6 races.

11.2.2 The final series will consist of maximum of 6 races plus the qualifying series score.

11.3 The scoring system including the number of excluded races will be described in full in the sailing instructions.

12 ADVERTISING & BOW NUMBERS

Boats may be required to display bow numbers and advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

13 MEASUREMENTS

13.1 Each boat shall comply with the requirements of the WASZP class rules in place at time of the event

13.2 Representatives of the WASZP Class, an official measurer and his or her delegates, or members of the jury may conduct inspections of equipment at any time during the regatta.

14 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be marked with her national letters, and shall register at the Race Office during the registration period.

15 BERTHING

15.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park.

15.2 **Boats must be tied on chains on their place during the night.**

16 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make nor receive radio transmissions, text messages or cellular phone calls while racing.



17 PRIZES

17.1 The following titles will be awarded:

1st overall: International Games Champion

1st placed citizen or resident of an European country: European Champion

1st Master: 45 years and older as of 1st August 2017

1st Junior: 18 years and younger as of 1st August 2017

1st Female

Prizes will be awarded also to: 2nd to 5th overall position

If spilt fleet is used: 1st, 2nd, & 3rd in Silver Fleet

1st placed: GPS speed event

17.2 Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organizers.

18 MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

18.1 By participating in the regatta, competitors grant to the organizing authority and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use, and show at the organizing authority's discretion any motion or still pictures, audio recordings, or similar media. This provision shall be interpreted as broadly as possible.

18.2 Competitors may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment, positioning equipment, or other electronic devices as provided by the organizing authority.

18.3 The top three competitors each day, as well as individual race winners, may be required to participate in a daily press conference.

18.4 Competitors may be required to be interviewed during the regatta.

19 RISK STATEMENT

19.1 Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

19.2 Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

19.2.1 They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;

19.2.2 They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;

19.2.3 They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omission;

19.2.4 Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;

19.2.5 The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organizer does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;

19.2.6 The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.

20 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of € 1.500.000,00 per event or the equivalent.

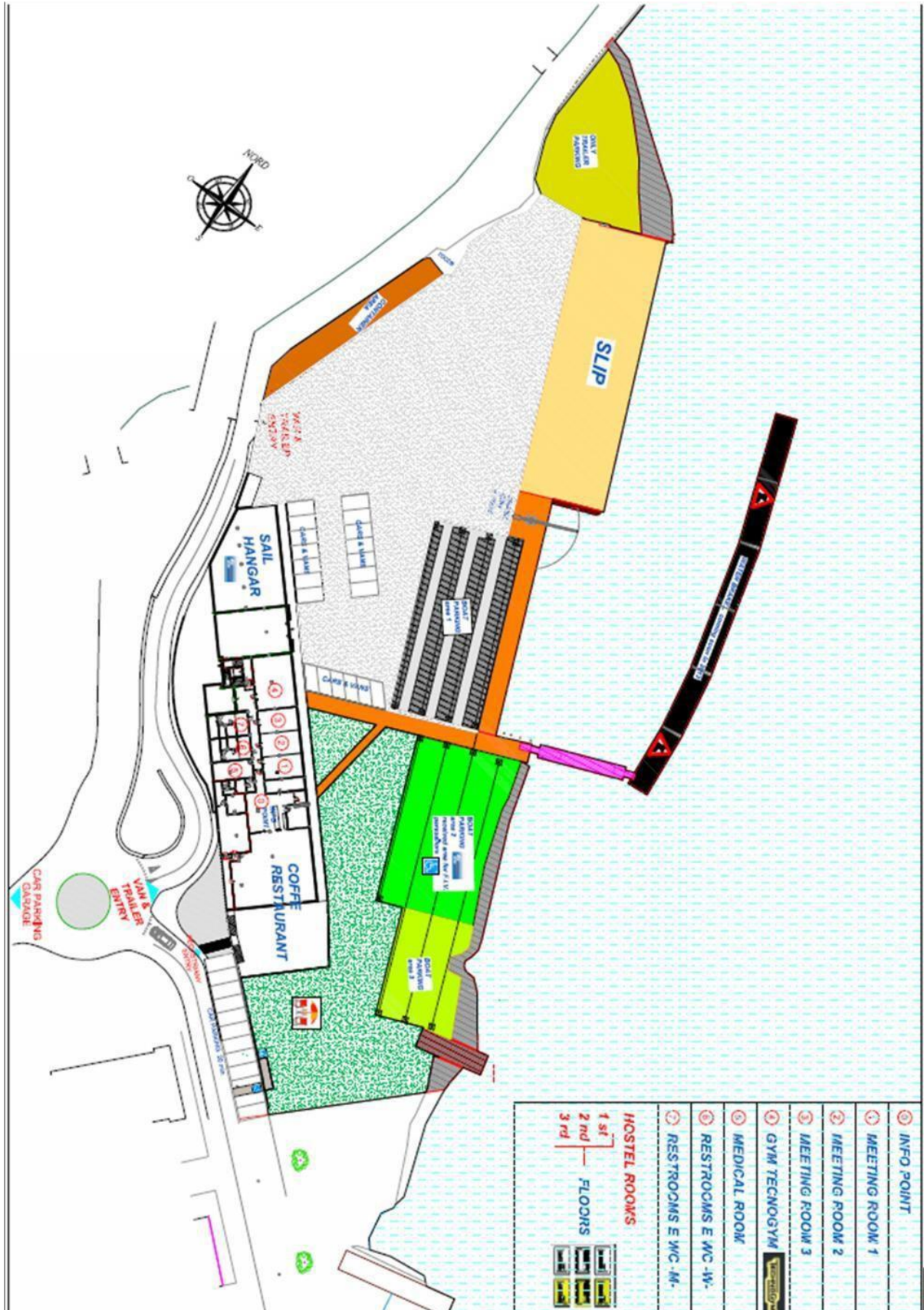
