NOTICE OF RACE

1. DATE, AND ORGANISING AUTHORITY

- 1.1. The Easter Foiling 2019 will be held at Campione del Garda from 19th to 21st April 2019.
- 1.2. The Organizing Authority for this regatta is Univela Sailing s.s.d.a r.l. in association with ASWC Lake Garda and in conjunction with the Associazione Italiana Classe Waszp and the Italian A Class

2. VENUE

3. RULES:

- 3.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 3.2. Rule 44.1 will be changed so that the two - turns penalty is replaced by the one-turn penalty.
- 3.3. The sailing instructions may consist contain minor changes to the RRS.
- 3.4. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all A-Division Catamaran Class certified boats and all boats of the WASZP Class.
- 4.2 Competitors must be registered at their National Class for the year 2019.
- 4.3 Competitors shall present upon registration:
 - a) Italian sailors shall show their FIV membership card 2019 with valid medical certificate.



- b) Foreigner sailors shall carry the membership card issued by their national authority.
- c) If necessary, a valid authorization to display advertising on boat;
- d) The measurement form or certificate of the boat, mast and sail
- e) A valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of € 1.500.000 per incident, or the equivalent

5. ENTRY FEES:

- 5.1. The pre-registrations shall be made by website : www.campioneunivela.it
The entry fees is € 120,00 and is to be paid by Credit Card by 7 April 2019.
Any later entry will be subject to the additional entry fees of € 30,00.
From 18 April the registrations can be made only in the secretary office of Univela Sailing.
- 5.2. The registration shall be displayed at the Entry List only when the Entry Form with all information filled in and the payment of the non-refundable entry fee shall be sent successfully.
The successful payment will be considered a confirmation of entry.

6. SCHEDULE

6.1. Races and social events are scheduled as follows:

On the last day of the regatta there will be no warning signal after 16:30 hrs.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available from 18 April 2019 at the race office upon registration.

8. RACING FORMAT

- 8.1. A total number of nine (9) races are scheduled.
- 8.2. No more than three races may be sailed per day

9. SCORING

- 9.1. The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply
- 9.2. The event will be valid even with only one valid race.
 - (a) When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When from six to eight races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding the worst score.
 - (c) When nine races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

10. MEASUREMENTS

- 10.1. Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate at registration.
- 10.2. Measurement and equipment inspection will be conducted in accordance with the WASZP Class rules and the A Class Catamaran Measurement Guidelines.



11. PRIZES

11.1. The following prizes will be awarded for A CAT sailor

- Prizes will be awarded to the first 3 classified overall;
- Junior: The top placed junior (aged less than 25);
- Master: Top placed master (aged 45-50);
- Grand Master: Top place grand master (aged 51-55);
- Great Grand Master: Top place great grand master (56+);
- Woman: Top place female sailor;
- Classic: Top non-foiling participant.

11.2. The following prizes will also be awarded for WASZP sailor

- Prizes will be awarded to the first 3 classified overall;
- Junior: The top placed junior (aged less than 21);
- Master: Top placed master (aged over 45);
- Woman: Top place female sailor.

11.3 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA

12. THE COURSES

12.1. The courses to be sailed will be posted in the Sailing Instruction,

13. ADVERTISING

13.1 Boats may be required to display the advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

14. PENALTY SYSTEM

14.1. Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

15. SUPPORT BOATS

15.1. All support boats shall be registered with the Organizing Authority and will be required to comply with local legislation and event support boat regulations.

The Organizing Authority may refuse registrations and accept later registrations at their sole discretion.

15.2. The registrant of a support boat will be charged for a not refundable fee of € 50.

The fee includes crane use (first and last day), trailer parking and berthing in the harbor.

15.3. Support boats with team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the starting sequence until all boats have finished or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment. Support boats shall comply with any reasonable request from the regatta officials.

16. RADIO COMMUNICATION

16.1. No equipment capable of radio transmissions or radio communications may be carried by any competitor while on the water. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones and other electronics devices.

17. PHOTOGRAPHY CONSENT

17.1. By entering the Championship competitors accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped participating in the race and/or using the regatta facilities and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, re-use, publication and republication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitor's name or not, without compensation and without the competitor's approval of such images or any use thereof.

18. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

18.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority and its officers, members and volunteers will not accept any liability for material



- damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 18.2. The establishment of the Notice of Race and the sailing Instruction in no way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibilities of a competitor being solely and entirely responsible for the management of a boat he is sailing.
 - 18.3. A competitor shall maintain his boat in a safe and seaworthy condition.
 - 18.4. A competitor shall be of good health and a competent sailor capable of racing a A-Class in open water in strong winds and it his sole responsibility to decide to participate in a race or to continue racing.

19. INSURANCE

- 19.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 per incident or the equivalent in currency.
- 19.2. Proof of insurance shall be provided on registration.
- 19.3. Any competitor under the age of 18 years old will be required to obtain parental/guardian written consent.

20. SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENT

- 20.1. General
By signing the entry fee, competitors shall comply with the following:
 - Put safety of yourself and competitors above race results
 - Keep the boat park and sailing area clean of any debrisDo not leave the boat park without the necessary safety precaution
- 20.2. A boat that retires from a race shall inform the race committee as soon as possible and before leaving the race area, and shall notify the race office at once on coming ashore.
- 20.3. Boats not leaving the harbor or beach for a day's race shall inform the race office prior to the start.
- 20.4. For vessels equipped with J or Z-boards, the helmsman must wear a safety helmet at all times while racing.

21. TRAILER PARKING, DOCKING AND CARS

- 21.1. All participants shall park their boats and road-trailers on the premises of the harbor Regatta Center. Cars shall be parked in the designated parking areas. No cars are allowed at the dinghy park. Please follow the beach master's and the harbor master's instructions at all times.

22. ACCOMODATION

Competitors shall make their own housing arrangements.

The building and the beach area are an unitary complex for accommodation purposes and equipment for leisure and sports services, where all sailors can find:

- Parking place for car, van and motorcycle *

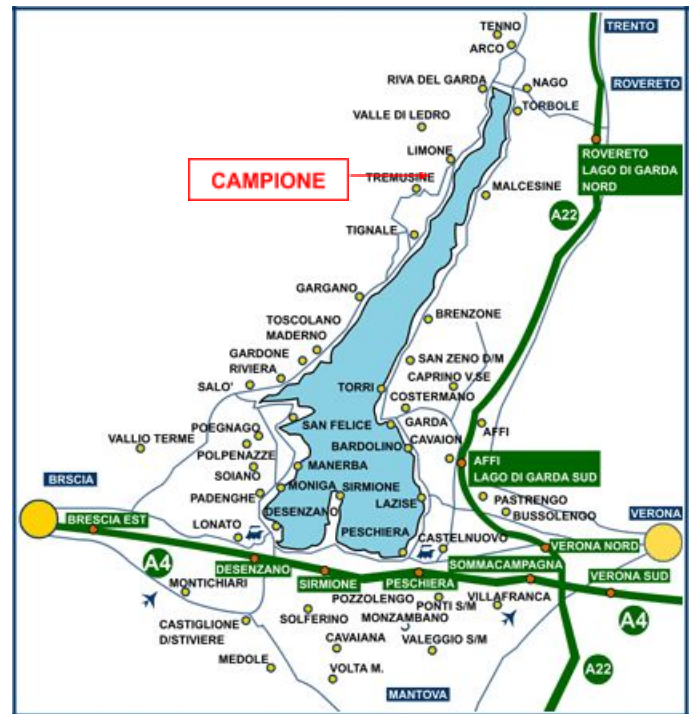
