Agreement Signed between San Marino Red Cross and CEMEC to Enhance Rescue Capabilities

The San Marino Red Cross (CRS) and the European Centre for Disaster Medicine (CEMEC) have inked a key agreement following years of fruitful collaboration. The joint declaration of intent, aimed at implementing joint projects in training and operational activities, seeks to enhance the skills and capabilities of both organizations for mutual benefit.
