The EPILS Course is an IRC Course that aims to train non-intensivist physicians, nurses, intra-hospital paramedics in recognising and treating adequately and effectively the infant and child in cardiorespiratory arrest until the arrival of the advanced rescue team (first minutes of care). It trains candidates to work in a team as members of a resuscitation team.

Included is a retraining of the PBLSD sequence and training on the most important skills in the management of the critical paediatric patient (balloon and mask ventilation, chest compressions, foreign body airway clearance, intraosseous access insertion).

Course prerequisite is having already acquired knowledge of PBLS
