We have completed a trial of the Medisystem, and have great results. After the 6 months Extended Trial period, using 3 Medibios units in the operating rooms, we are working to extend its use to all our operating rooms.

Amil Care Corp has supported us in training of our MSA workers and the EVS crew that terminally cleans the ORs as night.

With the reduction of microorganisms and the reduction in the length of time for terminally cleaning the rooms this is a great benefit for the Hospital. We reduce the chances of our patient contact surgical site infection and we can further expand this to cleaning of our hospital rooms with more efficiency and less cost than the UV light system.

According the literature there is an opportunity to reduce the rate of hospital acquired infections and save us in penalties from Medicare.
