RECIPE OF TODAY

Spaghetti with cherry tomatoes “scattarisciati”

(da velocissimo.it)

Ingredients: spaghetti, 4 tablespoons of extra virgin olive oil, 1 clove of garlic, 15 cherry tomatoes, salt, cheese, basil.

Put together in a pot 4-5 tablespoons of extra virgin olive oil and a clove of garlic, when the oil is hot (start smoking) remove the clove of garlic and pour a fortnight of tomatoes already cut into pieces, add salt and half a teaspoon of sugar and let it cook for three, four minutes. In another pot, prepare the spaghetti. Drain the pasta and season with the sauce you have prepared, turn it over well and add some cheese to your taste. Put a few leaves of raw basil after putting the spaghetti in the dishes. This is a quick but very tasty dish!



THE FESTIVITIES OF MID-AUGUST #3 LEUCA AND GALLIPOLI

Last episode of the tour with the patronal feasts of August in honor of Our Lady of the Assumption. After Otranto (which actually celebrates its Martyrs) and Alezio today we conclude with Leuca and Gallipoli. The first closes today the feast of the Madonna di Leuca with an evocative rite, linked to the maritime origins of this village. At 5.00 p.m., in fact, the procession starts and reaches the fishermen's port, where the procession at sea starts. On the way back the mass and follow the spectacular conclusion with the fireworks. In Gallipoli, however, the day of August 15 closes with fireworks around midnight at the pier foraneo, always in honor of Our Lady of the Assumption, but in reality are considered as the fires of August.
