A TRAM FOR GOING TO SEA



Last week we talked about Lecce, its baroque style and the beauties to be admired. Today, however, it is always Lecce that is written and its main square, that of Sant'Oronzo. Symbol of Lecce and Salento, it is the heart of the city, with its mix of ancient and recent history, from the Roman amphitheatre to the buildings of the Fascist period, obviously passing through the column of Sant'Oronzo, which from the top watches over the whole square. Once upon a time, however, there was also a tram (pictured opposite), which connected the city, to the nearby sea of San Cataldo. The tramway, which carried the

people of Lecce to the sea, worked from 1898 to 1933, had several operators but in the end the service was suppressed. In their hearts, considering the traffic of the city, the people of Lecce would not mind a tram that today takes them to the sea!

RECIPE OF TODAY

Spaghetti with anchovies and breadcrumbs

(da velocissimo.it)

Ingredients: spaghetti, fine breadcrumbs, cherry tomatoes, fresh rocket, anchovies in oil, garlic, olive oil, chilli.

In a pan, put some extra-virgin olive oil and breadcrumbs, leave to cook for a few minutes, always turning with a wooden spoon. Put the spaghetti to boil in plenty of salted water. In another large pan, which can contain all the spaghetti, put extra virgin olive oil and dissolve the anchovies diliscate, add the cherry tomatoes cut in half, the broken rocket and chopped garlic. Cook for 5 minutes, add the chilli pepper and salt. Separately cook the spaghetti and drain well al dente. Now pour them into the large pan with the seasoning, turn over, add the oil with the breadcrumbs and turn again. Serve.



THE DIOCESAN MUSEUM OF GALLIPOLI

Next to the Cathedral of St. Agatha, another shining example of Baroque Gallipoli is the Diocesan Museum. Inaugurated on 12/7/2004 it consists of 3 floors, full of numerous exhibitions, and a panoramic terrace from which you can admire the whole city. The building was built between 1750 and 1759 and hosted the ancient seminary for centuries. Inside you can find the cathedral's vestments, liturgical treasures and furnishings, the Quaremba room, reproduction of the bishop's throne, bells and relics. The highlights of the museum, for their artistic beauty and importance throughout the city, are the half silver busts of the patron saints of Gallipoli, Sant'Agata and San Sebastiano, both leaving the museum only during the periods of their festivals, January 19 and February 4. It is therefore not only a museum, but gathers all the testimonies of the faith of Gallipoli and the Diocese.
