## THE “DOXI” HISTORICAL LABEL

The most long-lived label of Cantina Coppola. It was one of the first wines to be bottled already in the 60s under the name of Doxi Vecchio. It takes its name from the noble family of the same name. The Doxis lived in a prestigious Baroque palace of 1700 in the historic centre of Gallipoli. Doxi Alezio DOC Rosso Riserva with 80% Negroamaro blend and 20% Black Malvasia, is cultivated in the Santo Stefano vineyard, with a spurred cordon back breeding system. The wine is aged in large oak barrels where it is aged for about two years. Ruby red color.

## RECIPE OF TODAY

### Escargots (moniceddhri) rosolates (da velocissimo.it)

**Ingredients: 1 kg of moniceddhri (snails), 1 glass of dry white wine, 2-3 bay leaves, extra virgin olive oil, 1 red onion, salt, chilli.**

They wash the snails well and take off their "cream". Take a fairly large baking sheet, put the oil and the onion cut into slices, salt and cook a little, wetting and turning to cook without browning. After draining the snails well, put them in the pot, add salt if necessary and continue cooking over a high flame. Add 2 or 3 bay leaves and, a few minutes before extinguishing the heat, soak them with a glass of good dry white wine. Allow to evaporate and serve hot.



## THE CHURCH OF SAN DOMENICO

The church of S. Domenico, also known as the church of the Rosary, is located on the Nazario Sauro Riviera in the historic center of Gallipoli. It is among the largest churches in the city, in addition to being also very old. Its construction dates back to the eighteenth century even if it was built on top of another sacred building of which there are some remains. The church has an external facade facing the sea, a common aspect of all the other churches that are along the walls, even if built in different eras. The structure is flanked by a cloister that was once the seat of a Dominican convent and is now a cultural center. The church and its activities are kept alive by the confraternity which has its seat in it and which takes its name from it. The Baroque style predominates from an artistic point of view, together with numerous paintings that embellish the 10 altars in the church.



## EVENTS

> **from June 20** in **Calimera** starts the 2018 edition of the **festival of street lamps and lu cuturusciu**, on the occasion of the feast of St. Louis, during which the city of greca Salentina lights up with shapes and colors scattered throughout the city. You can also taste the **cuturusciu**, a **doughnut of bread** with salt and pepper, the result of the dough left over from the processing of bread, a practice that was once preserved and disseminated.
