SANT'ORONZO AND HIS COLUMN



We continue with our little journey to the discovery of Lecce, suggesting places to see and telling curiosity about the places. Today we return to Piazza S. Oronzo, which takes its name from one of the three patron saints of Lecce: Oronzo, Giusto and Fortunato. Arriving on the square, you can see the column that for centuries has supported the statue of the saint, placed there to watch over the city and at the same time to symbolize the unbridled bond that has with the same. It was thanks to his intervention that the city and all the land of Otranto were able to free themselves from the plague. For this reason Brindisi, the city where the column was located and that together with another, symbolized the end of the ancient Via Appia, decided to give it to Lecce as a thank you. However, the Brindisians thought about it again almost immediately, and for this reason the Viceroy intervened, who decreed the transfer in a forced manner.



RECIPE OF TODAY

Spaghetti with cherry tomatoes “scattarisciati” (da velocissimo.it)

Ingredients: spaghetti, 4 tablespoons of extra virgin olive oil, 1 clove of garlic, 15 cherry tomatoes, salt, cheese, basil.

Put together in a pot 4-5 tablespoons of extra virgin olive oil and a clove of garlic, when the oil is hot (start smoking) remove the clove of garlic and pour a fortnight of tomatoes already cut into pieces, add salt and half a teaspoon of sugar and let it cook for three, four minutes. In another pot, prepare the spaghetti. Drain the pasta and season with the sauce you have prepared, turn it over well and add some cheese to your taste. Put a few leaves of raw basil after putting the spaghetti in the dishes. This is a quick but very tasty dish!

THE GARIBALDI THEATRE OF GALLIPOLI

The Municipal Theatre of Gallipoli was built at his own expense, as a plant theater, in 1825 by the nobleman Bonaventura Balsamo, who entitled it "Teatro del Giglio" in homage to the Bourbon family. It is located on site Sant'Agata, on an area of relevance of Palazzo Balsamo, on the main road axis of the city. Following the economic collapse of the Balsamo family, the theatre was acquired in 1874 by the Municipality, which entrusted the restoration project to the engineer Oronzo Bernardini from Lecce. The interior was completely renovated: particular attention was given to furniture and decorations; the façades of the boxes were enriched with gilded stucco and the boxes were completely upholstered in damask.



The carving works were entrusted to the gallipolini Salvatore Buccarella, Luigi Epifani and Francesco Nocera while the gilding was entrusted to the Neapolitan Tuvolo and the pictorial decorations to the very good Melchiorre Zalardi. In 1879 the theatre was named after Giuseppe Garibaldi. Recently the property has been completely restored.
