THE CASTLE OF OTRANTO

Otranto has represented, and still represents, the gateway to the East, a privileged place of encounter and clash between European and Asian civilization, between the Christian and Muslim worlds. Given its strategic position, which has always given it the role of outpost, Otranto has always been equipped with cutting-edge defensive systems. The castle represents the fulcrum of this system. This structure has been updated and reinforced after the two sieges it suffered: the first in 1067 and the second in 1480. The current structure was wanted by the Spanish Viceroy. Characteristic is certainly the spearheaded bastion, at that time one of the most modern architectural defense systems. Walking around the castle you can also admire the other towers: the Alfonsina, the Duchessa and the Hippolita. The beauty of the castle inspired the writer Horace Walpole, who in 1764 wrote the first Gothic novel in history, entitled: "The Castle of Otranto".

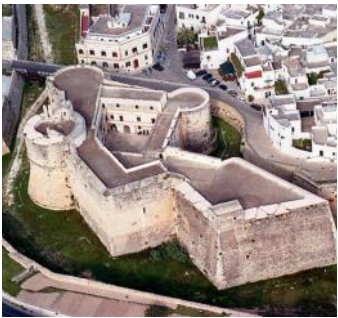
RECIPE OF TODAY

Peppers with breadcrumbs

(da velocissimo.it)

Ingredients: 500gr of yellow peppers, 300gr of breadcrumbs, 30gr of capers, salt, pepper, vinegar, extra virgin olive oil Cantina Coppola

Wash the peppers, cut them into pieces and fry them. In another pot put olive oil, a clove of garlic and breadcrumbs (when the oil is hot), taking care to turn everything so that nothing is burned. After a few minutes add the fried peppers and peppers and cook for a few more minutes in breadcrumbs and oil. When cooked, add the capers with a few drops of a good vinegar. Peperonata can be served hot or cold.



THE HINTERLAND OF GALLIPOLI #TAVIANO

Today we discover Taviano, a municipality bordering Gallipoli to the south. With its 12,000 inhabitants is an important center of Salento, thanks to its economy focused on flowers. Taviano is in fact called "City of Flowers" thanks to the flourishing floral production of the municipality. Mancaversa, its marina, allows the people of Taviano to have a place for the sea in the summer, which also attracts many tourists. Among the many traditions, the most important is the patron saint's feast of St. Martin in November, so late compared to the summer events in Salento, but for this reason is considered as the end of the season of the various patron saints. **There are many places to visit: the church of San Martino, that of the Madonna Addolorata, the old town, the seafront of Mancaversa.**

EVENTS

> in **Taviano** this evening the small **feast of Santa Marina**, in contrada crucicchie, the city's border with Racale. From the church, full of frescoes, will start the procession, followed by the fireworks display and evening of light music. There will also be local flavors with pittule, but also sandwiches padded for all tastes.

> In **Lecce**, the "**theatre of places**" exhibition of the **Korejaa theatre workshops** continues. With two simultaneous shows: one at the Palmieri boarding school and the other at the Sigismondo Castromediano museum. In both places there will be, respectively, the WS tempest, reinterpretation of "The Storm" by Shakespeare and "The Fifteen Thousand Steps", a performance for voice and double bass, Info/reservations: 0832/242000
