EMOJI, BETWEEN COLOURS AND MEANINGS

They are now part of everyday digital language when we communicate with others through chats and social networks. We're talking about emoji of course, about the small drawings we send to communicate a message to someone else, when we have nothing to say or we don't need too many words. The term is derived from Japanese and means pictogram, a symbol whose meaning is immediately recognizable. The first smiley was developed by Shigetaka Kurita and today there are about 2800, now available on all platforms. Every year the Unicode system, in which the emoji have been inserted, always recognizes new ones, nourishing the curiosity for all the new symbols that can be created and sent. Every day, an average of 500 million emojis circulate in the various social networks, a demonstration that short and symbolic communication is often preferred by users, not only because of its rapid and intuitive transmission of meanings but also because a coloured drawing may seem more pleasant than a grey text without colour.

The Rocci di Cantina Coppola, the first white Negroamaro ever, was born in 2006 from the intuition of Carlo Antonio Coppola and the oenologist Giuseppe Pizzolante Leuzzi, convinced that the peculiar organoleptic characteristics of Negroamaro could also give the white wine a structure of great impact. The first vintages were bottled as Table Wine, because no DOC and IGT contemplated the vinification of Negroamaro in white. Subsequently, the name of Igt Puglia was obtained. RECIPE OF TODAY

Trifled courgettes

(da velocissimo.it)

Ingredients: 1kg of courgettes, parsley, salt,
Extra virgin olive oil Cantina Coppola

Cut the courgette into cubes, sprinkle with salt and put it in a colander. In another pan put some extra virgin olive oil, a clove of garlic, and leave to warm well. Put the courgettes that we have left for at least a quarter of an hour in the colander, and we will turn carefully taking care not to ruin them. Add the salt and, at the end of cooking, plenty of chopped parsley.



THE CHURCH AND CONVENT OF SAINT TERESA

Another example, among the most beautiful, of baroque Lecce is the church of St. Theresa, in the historic center of Gallipoli. The church, commissioned by Bishop Perez de la Lastra and built between 1687 and 1690, is flanked by the convent of the cloistered nuns of Santa Teresa. Both seem almost to hide at the end of the road that runs along the facade of the cathedral, yet once you cross the entrance threshold the beauty of polychrome marble and flooring, combined with decorations in Lecce stone and the care with which the church is guarded, leave you amazed. Surely the most beautiful part is the high altar, carved in Lecce stone by the Neapolitan Gennaro Cima-Fonte.
