PEOPLE AND BREAD

White, brown, with cereal, sweet or stuffed, bread is certainly one of the most consumed products, the first thing that you give to those who ask for something to eat and the basic food for almost all the peoples of the world. The history of bread has always been linked to the development of agriculture, when man began, after centuries of nomadism, to settle in the territories more or less permanently, giving way to stable crops, including wheat. However, there are some recent findings near Jordan that suggest a production of bread prior to the development of agriculture, dating from the Paleolithic period. Scholars from the universities of Cambridge, Copenhagen and London have analysed the crumbs discovered on that site and found that the men of that era would use wild cereals to make bread, thus confirming the existence of bakers even in that remote era. This is how a food binds men over time.

RECIPE OF TODAY <u>Stuffed aubergines</u>

<u>(da Velocissimo.it)</u> Ingredients: 1kg of eggplant, 400gr of breadcrumbs, 300gr ripe tomatoes, 2 tablespoons capers, parsley, salt, oregano, extra virgin olive oil Cantina Coppola

Cut the eggplants, sprinkle them with salt and put them in a colander so that they become less loved. In a bowl, soak the breadcrumbs with plenty of oil, add the ripe pulp of the tomatoes cut into pieces, the chopped parsley, the oregano, salt, pepper and capers full of vinegar. Then put on each slice of eggplant part of the previously prepared mixture, cover with another slice and infiltrate the dumplings thus obtained with toothpicks. Before putting them on the embers, wet them with a drizzle of olive oil. They can also be baked in a very hot oven, or on an electric grid.



THE COPPOLA COLLECTION HALL

In the historic center of Gallipoli, among the various churches and museums there is a treasure chest of art closely linked to the history of the Coppola family. The place in question is the Coppola Hall, a small picture gallery that collects nineteen paintings attributable to Giovanni Andrea Coppola, an important exponent of Apulian painting of the 600, which the heirs of the family decided to donate in 1982. The themes of the paintings in the room are almost all of a religious nature, typical of the art of the 600, with the exception of the still life of fruit and flowers with mushrooms, birds, baskets, flasks and a crystal vase, a painting that, following the restoration financed by Banca Popolare Pugliese, has been brought back to Giacomo Coppola, in activity since the beginning of the 600. Definitely one of the most beautiful of the collection. This small presentation is not enough to tell the beauty of the paintings and the importance of the author, so as well as invite you to visit the Hall, which our guests access for free with the bracelet, we refer you to upcoming events on these pages.
