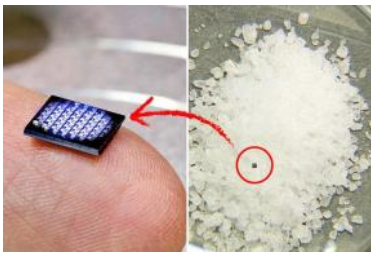

RECIPE OF TODAY

Aubergine balls

(da velocissimo.it)

Ingredients: 500gr eggplant, 200gr gr grated pecorino cheese, 200gr gr grated bread, 2 or 3 eggs, basil, oil, salt and pepper.

Wash the aubergines, cut them lengthwise, sprinkle with salt and put them in a colander with a weight on top so that they lose a part of their bitterness. Cook in plenty of salted water. Leave to cool down, squeeze well between hands to remove excess water and grind. Add some cheese, breadcrumbs, parsley, basil, eggs, salt and pepper (as needed). Mix everything together well, form meatballs, flour and put them in boiling oil.

THE HINTERLAND OF GALLIPOLI #ALEZIO

For years, almost always, there has been a conflict between the inhabitants of Gallipoli and Alezio about which of the two cities was born first, given that their ties are so intertwined in history that they have been lost over the centuries. On the basis of rather ancient historical sources (Pliny the Elder) it emerged, however, that Alezio was the first to be founded, with Gallipoli being in fact the port that served the hinterland. Alezio, a municipality of Messapian origins, is already standing in the fourth century BC, a date witnessed by the tombs found (such as the necropolis of Montedelia) dating back to that period and the funerary equipment typical of those populations. The city has a swinging history, with phases of abandonment and reconstruction, all linked to the history of Gallipoli, since the problems of one were reflected on the other. During the late Middle Ages, after a period of neglect, Alezio began its recovery thanks to the construction of the Sanctuary of S.M. della Lizza (which we will talk about) dating from the twelfth century, which also became for a certain period of time the cathedral of the Diocese of Gallipoli, during the siege of Charles I of Anjou in 1269. Thanks to its climate many nobles decided to build summer residences and palaces, resulting in a further accelerated urban growth of the center, until 1854, when it obtained administrative autonomy from Gallipoli and in 1873 assumed its current name, replacing the old name of Villa Picciotti. **To visit: the sanctuary of S.M. della Lizza, the Church of Our Lady of Sorrows, the municipal museum and the adjacent Messapian necropolis.**
