## ILLUMINATIONS AND THE ART OF LIGHTS

The feast of Scorrano stands as a vanguard for its illuminations, attracting visitors from all over the world, with Chinese and Japanese delegations. But it is not the only town to be so well lit, since all the cities of Salento compete to have the most beautiful paratura. The history of the illuminations is rooted in the noon of Italy, from Rome down, but in Salento this sector has always been among the most important, also from the economic point of view. These lighting structures began to develop in the 1930s, thanks to the progressive spread of electricity, even though their origin dates back a few centuries. Arcs, espaliers, pediments and caisson transform the cities, as if time stopped to relive festivals and traditions that have been characterizing this territory for centuries.

**THE “DOXI”  
HISTORICAL  
LABEL**

The most long-lived label of Cantina Coppola. It was one of the first wines to be bottled already in the 60s under the name of Doxi Vecchio. It takes its name from the noble family of the same name. The Doxis lived in a prestigious Baroque palace of 1700 in the historic centre of Gallipoli. Doxi Alezio DOC Rosso Riserva with 80% Negroamaro blend and 20% Black Malvasia, is cultivated in the Santo Stefano vineyard, with a spurred cordon back breeding system. The wine is aged in large oak barrels where it is aged for about two years. Ruby red color.

## RECIPE OF TODAY

### Mussels in semolina

(da velocissimo.it)

**Ingredients:** 1 kg of mussels, 150gr of semolina, 1lt of water, extra virgin olive oil of Cantina Coppola pepper, parsley, garlic

Wash the mussels well and put them on a low heat, without adding water, until they open. Remove them from the valves and collect them in a bowl. The water coming out of the mussels is filtered and kept aside. In a pot, heat the olive oil of Cantina Coppola, add a clove of garlic and the water from the mussels. When it starts to boil add more water, if necessary, to cook the semolina. When it boils everything pour in the semolina and cook it, always turning with a wooden spoon. Finally, put the mussels in it and taste them to see if it is necessary to add salt or not. Before serving, sprinkle with pepper and chopped parsley.



### The Church of the Holy Cross in Lecce

In the heart of the historic center of the capital is the most baroque of the monuments of this city, the church of Santa Croce with the adjoining palace of the Celestines, a former convent. The two structures are rich in decorations, typical of the exaggerated style of Baroque, and catch the tourist by surprise appearing at the end of a small street, without any particularly large square that can announce them. Among the artists who worked there was Giuseppe Zimbalo, author of the most important monuments of that period in Salento, although the construction of the church lasted almost two centuries, with completion in the late 1600s. Currently the church is being restored, however this problem can turn into an additional opportunity for you, since on the website [www.booking.restausantacrocelecece.it](http://www.booking.restausantacrocelecece.it) you can book a guided tour with the elevator leading face to face with the Lecce stone worked centuries ago. Here's how to make the most of a sad cage for beauty!

> The **celebrations** in honour of **Santa Domenica in Scorrano**, which for 4 days dresses up in light, become the absolute capital of the illuminations, come to life. Today together with the light shows, day of **fireworks** with daytime spectacles at 12:00 and night at 24:00, with several companies involved.

> Continue the **Salento Book Festival**, which stops in **Galatone** at the atrium of Palazzo Marchesale from 20:30 with Fabio Calenda presenting his book "Money is everything" and with Beppe Vessicchio and his latest editorial work "Music makes tomatoes grow".

> The event "**The song of the sirens, the pink night in Gallipoli**" will start on July 7. The event is organized by the municipality and the equal opportunities commission to promote the role of women in society.
